INFORMATION – ELDERLY PEOPLE

× Skills requirements

- + mobile enough to come to the meetings
- + enough endurance and strength
- + good cognition
- + enjoy teaching
- × To do
 - + distribute flyers in the city and in the adult education centre
 - + introduce the project at a meeting of elderly people
 - + offer the project to nursing home residence



INFORMATION - CHILDREN

× Skills requirements + minimum age 6 years + good cognition + good motor skills + concentration × To do + present the project to a school + distribute flyers



TIMELINE

- initial meeting with the elderly people
 cooking dates

 two following weeks
 Friday afternoon and the following Saturday morning
 - + four hours per meeting
- × debriefing session with the children
- debriefing session with the elderly people



PREMISES

- kitchen with 4 cooking bays and a dining room
- × a good, accessible kitchen
- × enough space
- × complete range of kitchen equipment
- × facilities to keep the food cool
