## Position Statement on Human Rights

- o Right to participate in a range of occupations that enables them to flourish, fulfil their potential and experience satisfaction....
- o Right to be supported to participate in occupation as an included and valued member of the family, community and society...
- o Right to choose for themselves & not be pressured, forced or coerced into occupations that threaten health or are dehumanising, degrading or illegal

# World Federation of Occupational Therapists Position Statement on Human Rights

- o Access to civic, educational, productive, social, creative, spiritual and restorative occupations
- o Valued for participation and have equitable access, regardless of difference
- o Not be excluded from occupations by economic, social and physical barriers....
